書院服務體驗實習計劃 College Service Learning Internship Programme

書院於本年暑假,舉辦了全新的服務體驗實習計劃。二十位同學脫穎而出,遠赴台灣、泰國及緬甸,在當地的非牟利機構(Connecting Myanmar、台灣南澳自然田、台灣玩具圖書館協會及桃園縣教育志工聯盟)安排下,透過義教、籌辦玩具圖書館、體驗耕作、與居民接觸等,親身了解當地的文化及服務當地的貧窮階層及弱勢群體。此計劃不但拓寬了同學的視野,更令同學對社會、生活、物質等議題作出反思。

The College Service Learning Internship Programme was successfully held this summer. Twenty students were selected to participate in the programmes coordinated by the non-government organisations in Taiwan, Thailand and Myanmar (i.e. Connecting Myanmar, Taiwan Nanao Natural Farm, Taiwan Toy Library Association and Taoyuan County Education Volunteer Alliance Corp). Through the voluntary service at local schools, natural farm and toy libraries, students interacted with children from low-income families and underprivileged in society, which made the participants to have reflection in many aspects of their lives.


